PROCLAMATION
BY THE
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, injuries are the leading cause of death among Kansas children ages 1 to 19; and

WHEREAS, many injuries are largely predictable and preventable; and

WHEREAS, the state of Kansas is committed to creating a safe environment contributing to the safety and well-being of our children; and

WHEREAS, hospitals, state and local agencies, and statewide and community organizations are committed to their crucial role in reducing injuries and deaths by promoting safe practices; and

WHEREAS, National Injury Prevention Day raises awareness and promotes efforts to reduce injuries and violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Laura Kelly, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, do hereby proclaim November 18, 2024, as

National Injury Prevention Day

in the state of Kansas and I urge all citizens to join in this observation.
