WHEREAS, many of these injuries and loss of life are preventable with the use of safety practices and equipment; and

WHEREAS, hospitals, state agencies, community organizations, and other partners are crucial in promoting these safe practices that can lead to saving lives and preventing injury; and

WHEREAS, along these partners, the City of Saint Paul joins in a commitment to promoting efforts that reduce injuries and loss of life among children:
