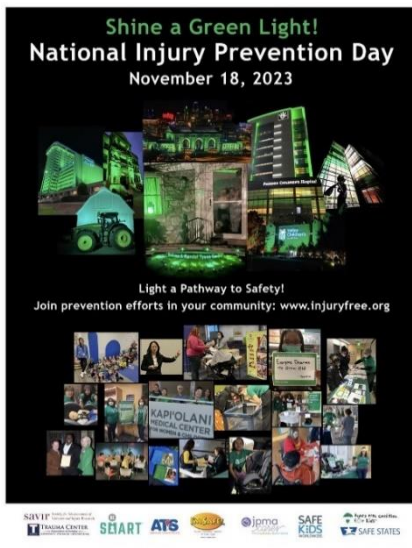

National Injury Prevention Day 2023

On November 18th, 2023, the Injury Free Coalition for Kids® established the 1st National Injury Prevention Day (NIPD) in the United States. This day was modeled after National Injury Prevention Day Canada, which was established by Parachute Canada, a national charity dedicated to injury prevention in July 2017. In the US, National Injury Prevention Day seeks to raise awareness about the burden of injury on the lives of all people. In the inaugural year, 22 cities participated and shined a green light on iconic buildings and landmarks, conducted injury prevention programs and events, promoted NIPD through traditional media and multiple social media platforms, and obtained proclamations from policymakers recognizing injuries as the **#1 cause of death for all persons aged 1-44 years old** (CDC, 2020). Since 2020, National Injury Prevention Day (NIPD) has grown by building new partnerships and enhancing existing partnerships in bringing attention to the burden of death and disability resulting from both unintentional and intentional injuries and violence. The number of people educated and empowered to create change in their own communities has increased as well. During the 4th Annual National Injury Prevention Day (NIPD) 180 organizations/institutions in 95 cities and 38 states participated, a 20% increase from 2022. A total of 395 activities comprised of shining green lights, community-based injury prevention education, internal staff education and proclamation requests marked a successful national injury prevention campaign.

National Injury Prevention Day Kick off Webinar, November 17th, 2023, 10 AM EST:

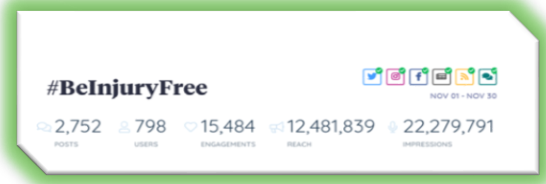


The one-hour webinar, “Unifying Voices” was moderated by one of the founding partners of NIPD, Wendy Pomerantz, MD. The three featured speakers represented multiple sectors in the field of injury prevention. Benjamin Hoffman, MD, President-Elect of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) initiated the discussion from the lens of a practicing pediatrician whose future position with the AAP will help elevate injury prevention in clinical practice. His insightful talk was followed by Sam Posner, PhD, Acting Director of the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control (NCIPC/CDC) who educated participants about the

magnitude of the injury problem and the federal efforts in research and funding opportunities that have been created to decrease death and disability due to injury and violence. Kyran Quinlan, MD, Pediatric Medical Advisor to the Director of the Illinois Department of Public Health provided his perspective on the importance of working together at all levels to make communities safer and increase the health and safety of children across the country through partnerships and the translation of research to practice. All NIPD Partners were represented as they reinforced the NIPD messages and need for advocacy and education for all. The Partners included Torine Creppy (Safe Kids Worldwide), Richard Hamburg (Safe States), McKenzie Riley (American Trauma Association), and Bonnie Koziel (American Academy of Pediatrics). Ana Acosta and Jamie Troyer of Trauma Center Association of America (TCAA) discussed the results of their successful NIPD media contest. Annie Andrews, MD, Senior Advisor for Everytown for Gun Safety highlighted the gun violence epidemic and how in 2023 it remains a leading cause of death for children and teens in America and how the Be SMART program is “empowering the community by educating adults and offering practical and accessible tools so we can change the culture.” The webinar was attended by over 170 attendees.

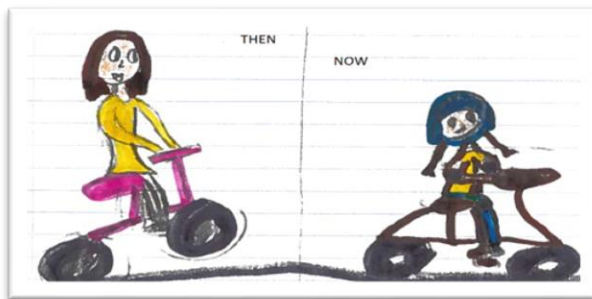
A one-hour lively discussion with more 798 users was hosted through the X platform (Twitter) using hashtag **#BeInjuryFree**. Promotional graphics were created and available for all to use. The Injury Free social media subcommittee created eight questions for discussion, provided instructions and provided support for participants. The topics included firearm safety, injury prevention strategies for disabled individuals, the harms of cannabis ingestion, opioid overdoses, and product recalls.



Trauma Center Association of America (TCAA) Nationwide Media Contest:

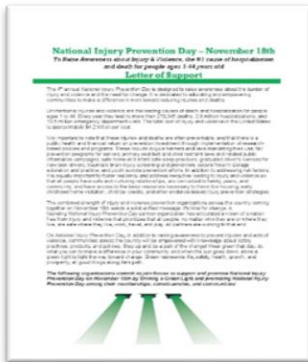
TCAA's Injury Prevention Committee sponsored a media contest to spread the word about preventing injuries in our communities – Participants from elementary school through college were asked to show us **what the evolution of safety looks like in their community.**

The Committee received ninety-one entries. Twenty prizes were awarded in four categories in each of five age groups totaling \$3,000. The winners were announced on National Injury Prevention Day, November 18th.

The Safe States Alliance is an NIPD Partner. Richard Hamburg, Executive Director, produced a sign-on letter highlighting reasons to join the national effort to raise awareness about the burden of injury and violence and the need for change. It also provides injury statistics and the vision of NIPD which is educating and empowering communities to make a difference toward reducing injuries and deaths. Safe States solicited signers for the NIPD support letter from other organizations Eighty-two hospitals and organizations signed the letter and committed to joining forces to support and promote NIPD by promoting the day among their memberships, constituencies, and communities and taking part in the activities of the day. The document was shared with members of the US Congress as a form of advocacy and education to lawmakers. Safe States also participated in promotional webinars, and promoted the event with partners/members via email and social media throughout October and November 2023.

MHI Brands provided toilet locks- Regal Lager/Qdos donated safety gates, and bath thermometers were a popular donation item-from Munchkin. These products are essential for keeping children

safe from unintentional injuries as they start exploring their surroundings. They serve to make homes safer for babies, toddlers, and children with special needs.

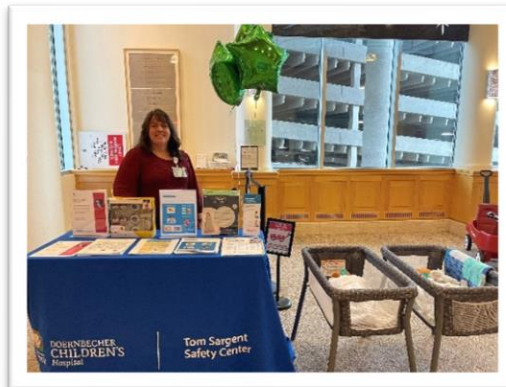

- 2 Put them to sleep in their own space.
- 3 Use a firm and flat mattress.

Sites identified numerous items that went well during their observation of NIPD Day. 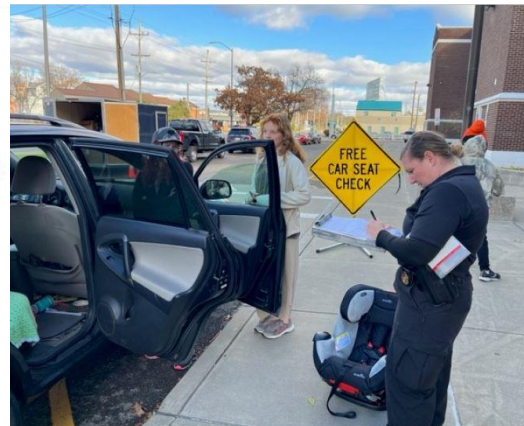

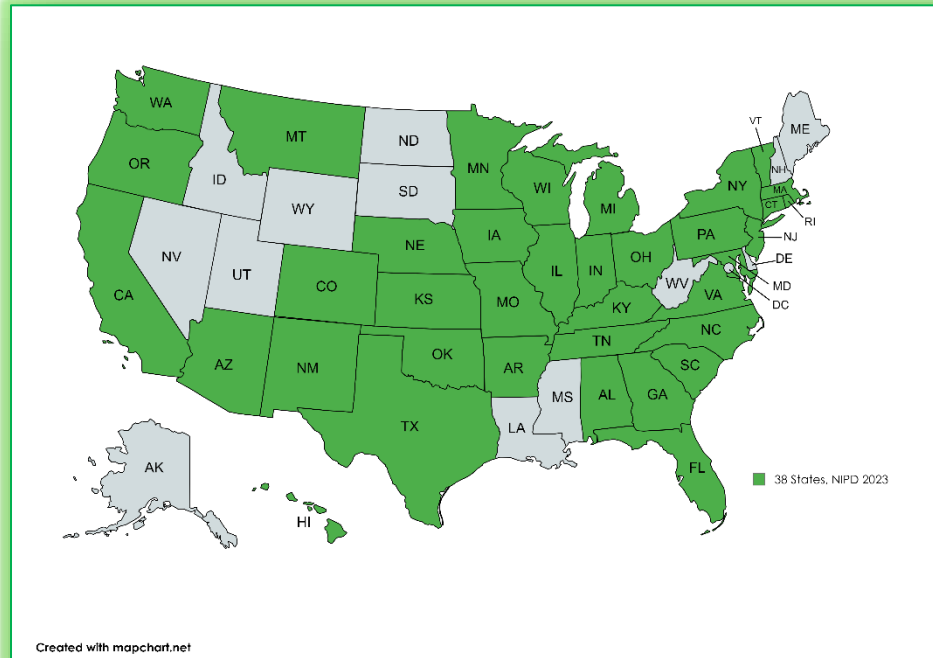
