





Staging gun buybacks also provides us with the opportunity to gather useful data on the individuals who voluntarily participate in these events, and anonymously

complete surveys. This data allows for us to better understand the reasons for having a gun in the home, who has access to the gun, storage practices, reasons for turning in the gun, demographics and distance traveled to the event.

Swords to Plowshares Northeast was created in 2017 as a violence prevention outreach program focused on reducing senseless firearm injuries and deaths.

with many of our tools donated to community gardens and agricultural high schools. In this way, we look to break the cycle of violence that guns perpetuate. By transforming guns into tools and jewelry, we

Our team works closely with municipalities and law enforcement agencies to organize gun buyback events in the spirit of public safety and injury prevention. These events are organized with the hopes of making our homes and communities safer.
